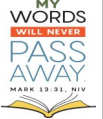

COUPLES BIBLE STUDY: "ROMANS 8: FROM BROKEN TO BELONGING" BY NOE GARCIA. This 7 session study is a focus on applying the biblical truths of Romans 8 to the struggles people experience personally with special emphasis on how these issues affect Christian marriages. Some of the topics covered are: depression, anxiety, hurting relationships, unmet expectations, shame, suffering, loneliness, and feelings of hopelessness. The study consists of scripture study, group discussions and personal home study. Those interested should meet in room 103 in the Worship Center. Study meets at 5pm on Sunday.

Topics covered are: Busy Lifestyles, Emotional Distress, Financial Difficulties, Conflict, Feelings of Isolation, Feeling Overwhelmed, Disciplining Children and Parenting Teens and Young Adults.
