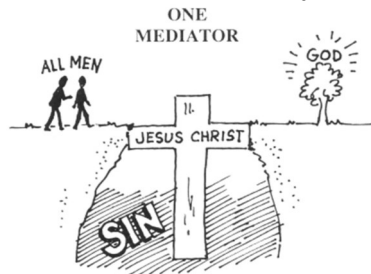


REFLECTIONS ON LIFE

In today's world, there are Christians who believe that angels can be worshiped. Thus, they pray to these heavenly beings to serve as their mediators between them and God. But the Bible clearly teaches that we are not to worship angels or pray to them. Angels, as eternal spiritual entities, are part of God's heavenly creation and are not divine (see Colossians 1:16 and Hebrews 1:11-14). They were created for God's purposes (to worship, praise, and carry out God's commands in a variety of ways) and for His glory (see Psalm 148:2). Angels are subject to judgment for wrongdoings as reflected in 2 Peter 2:4. Holy angels deserve our respect but they are not worthy of being worshiped (see Colossians 2:18 and Revelation 22:9). 1 Timothy 2:5 lets us know that our Lord and Savior Jesus is the only mediator between us and God.

WHO'S WHO & WHERE'S WHERE

JOAB

(FIRST MENTIONED IN 2 SAMUEL 2:13)

Joab was the military man behind Israel's most successful warrior king, David — the ruler who put Israel on the map and secured its borders. All three sons of David's sister Zeruiah fought in David's army. But the job of commander went to Joab after he rose to David's challenge to lead the attack on Jerusalem. Cunning and courageous though he was, Joab was also driven by revenge and power. When Abner, the general of King Saul's successor's army, wanted to switch sides to David — Joab murdered him. He did it because Abner had killed one of his brothers. Joab also later killed David's son Absalom, who led a coup, even though David had asked his soldiers to spare the prince. For this, David replaced Joab with Amasa. But Joab murdered him too, and got his job back. David chose Solomon to be his successor and asked Solomon to remember Joab's murders. Joab was executed as he held on to the altar at Jerusalem's worship center.
