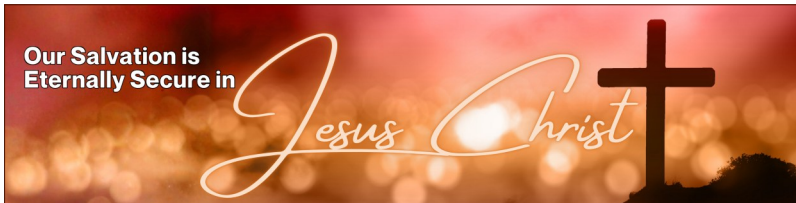

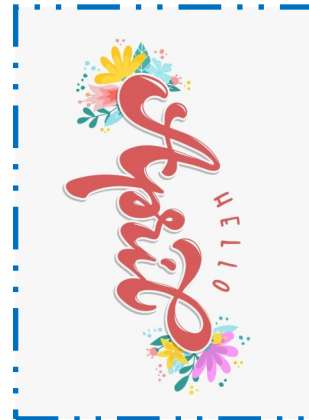

NOB

King Saul's insane jealousy toward the popular young David, his son-in-law, turned David into a fugitive. Running south from Gibeah, David and some men stopped at Nob — a neighboring village. Israel's worship center had apparently moved there after the Philistines destroyed the one at Shiloh. That earned the city its nickname "the town of the priests" (1 Samuel 22:19). Without telling Ahimelech the priest that he was on the run, David got some bread and took the sword of Goliath that was kept there. Saul's chief shepherd Doeg saw this and reported it to the king. Furious, Saul called the priest and all his associates, wrongly accused them of treason, and ordered his bodyguards to kill them — 85 priest in all and their families. Only one son - Abiathar - survived. He joined David and later became Israel's high priest.
